Growing in Grace Opportunities Sunday Bible Study ... Main Area

This may be because of apathy, fear of potential negative reactions to our Biblical convictions (fear of confrontation), or simply because we do not feel qualified to speak clearly and correctly on the topics in question. Have you ever felt that a discussion of an important Christian question was "out of your league"? Are there other "excuses" that we might give? Scripture tells us that we should not hesitate to give a clear testimony to others whenever we have the opportunity to speak the truth and express our faith. Let's grow together in our ability to provide some answers.
