Epiphany Focus ... The Church Worship Season of Epiphany began with our worship on January 5. Epiphany in a nutshell means 'appearing;' Jesus appeared among us, showing Himself to be the Promised One through His speech and His actions. The Season of Epiphany reminds us that Jesus, a helpless infant at Christmas and who walked among people in the form of a servant did at times let rays of divine glory shine through. Jesus is indeed true God (always has been) and true Man (through the incarnation), a

necessary truth for our salvation. The Epiphany Season prepares us for the 'what and why' of Lent.
